# B.A. (Hons.)

## English 3 YEARS

B.A. (Hons.) English Programme offered by The NorthCap University will help students to become an expert in reading, analyzing and discussing literary texts. The curriculum for B.A. (Hons.) English covers the cultural, social, historical and political dimensions of key events and eras that have had a huge impact on today's civilization. The Programme aims to develop awareness about different cultures and ethnicities among the students through different forms of literature. The students will be introduced to the study of major genres, styles, and forms of literature so that they can acquire both sensitivity and creativity.

### Eligibility Criteria

10+2 examination conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education or equivalent examination from a recognized board in any stream. Must qualify CUET-UG/ Any other National Test in the discipline of UG programme.

In case a student has not appeared in any of the above-mentioned entrance examinations, NCU will conduct its own entrance test in the discipline of UG programme.

## Dual Degree Pathway with University of East Anglia (UEA), UK



The Centre for Language Learning (CLL) at The NorthCap University, Gurugram, has an academic partnership with the Faculty of English at the University of East Anglia (UEA), UK. This collaboration is anchored in a dual-degree pathway designed to enrich the academic and global exposure of students enrolled in the BA (Hons.) English programme at NCU.

Under this initiative, students can pursue:

- **Two years of study at NCU**, focusing on foundational and interdisciplinary literary training.
- **One year at UEA**, where they will engage with advanced modules in English Literature and undertake a dissertation project.

Upon successful completion, students will be awarded:

- **A BA (Hons.) English** degree from NCU
- **A BA English Literature** degree from UEA

This partnership is built on shared pedagogical values and a commitment to fostering critical inquiry, interdisciplinary engagement, and global academic standards. CLL views this collaboration as a significant step toward expanding literary horizons and offering students a transformative international academic experience.



# M.A ENGLISH

2 YEARS

## Eligibility Criteria

Candidate must have successfully completed a Bachelor's degree from a recognized University. Must qualify CUET-PG/Any other National Test in the discipline of PG programme.

In case a student has not appeared in any of the above-mentioned entrance examinations, NCU will conduct its own entrance test in the discipline of PG programme.

In order to strengthen students' foundational knowledge of literature in English, M.A. English programme at NCU will allow students to be exposed to both canonical as well as contemporary literature.

The M.A. English curriculum is designed to help students understand various literary periods; become familiar with different domains of literary study; and recognize the changes that have come about in the field of literary criticism. This will prepare them to succeed in both academic careers and those that lie outside academia. They will also be encouraged to identify a research area and gain some understanding of the same while working closely with a faculty member for their dissertation.

M.A. English degree will equip the students to face challenges of 21st century professional spaces with confidence. Since post-graduation is mandatory qualification for teaching at University level in India, our M.A. programme will benefit those who aspire for University Teaching. It shall also act as a bridge to the Ph.D. programme for the students.

# PhD in ENGLISH

Academic research is a vital component of any university, and NCU is renowned for its research-intensive environment and diverse range of academic disciplines. Our Ph.D. English programme has proved to be a major success among research scholars. It allows students to collaborate closely with a committed faculty from CLL and other academic units within the university.

Scholars pursuing PhD in English are encouraged to pursue research on a topic of their own interest. To learn about the latest trends and developments in the field of literature, they are supported by the University to attend conferences, seminars, workshops etc., and to publish their research in reputed journals such as those listed by Web of Science, Scopus, etc. The Ph.D. Programme is offered in both full-time and part-time mode, with fellowship opportunities available for meritorious and deserving full time Ph.D. scholars.

## Eligibility Criteria

PG Degree with minimum 60% marks (for Engineering, Management, Applied Sciences and Psychology) / 55% marks for Law and English.

5% relaxation in minimum eligibility criteria for working professionals except for Law and English

OR

UG Degree with minimum 75% marks or 8.5 CGPA

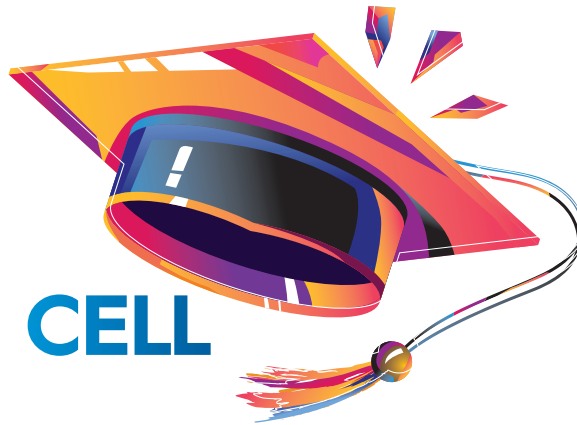
Postgraduate research deepens scholarly engagement with literature, language, and communication, fostering both independent and collaborative inquiry.
