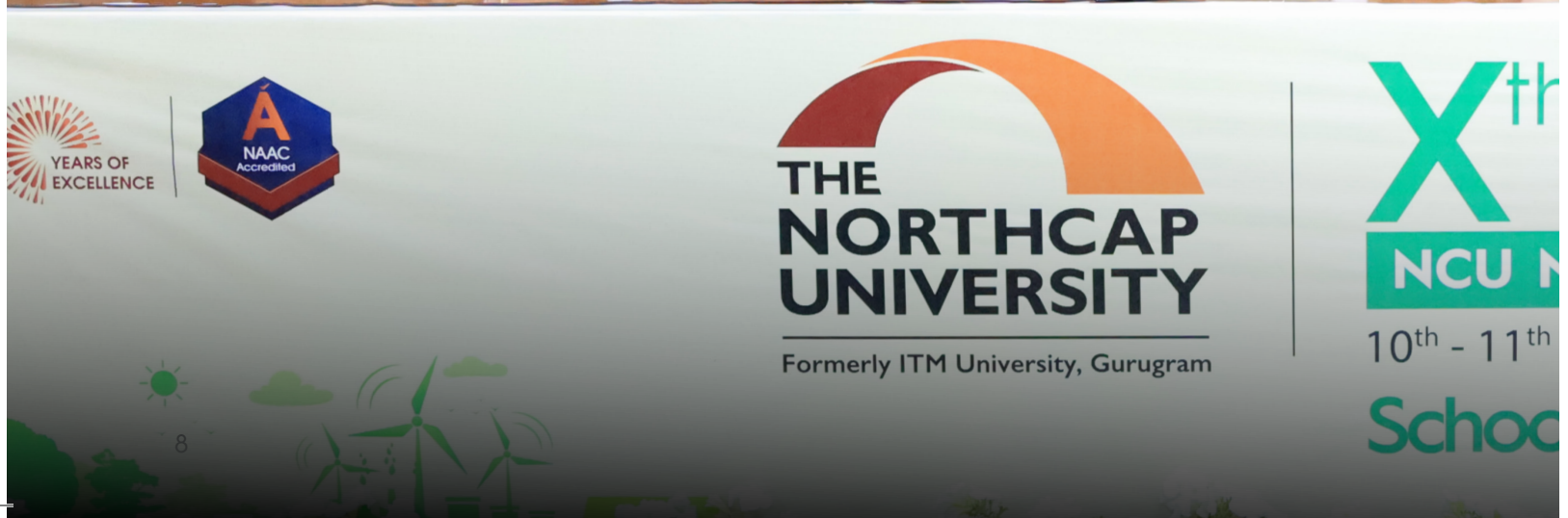
# A Vibrant Mooting Culture at School of Law

# Centres of Excellence

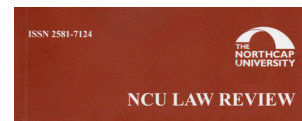
# Legal Aid Society

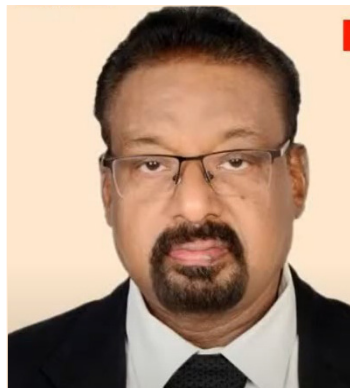
