

How to check indexing of Journals

These are some simple steps to check your Journal publications (**Sciences, Engineering, Management, Law, and Arts & Humanities**) in the below mentioned databases:

1. Web of Science
2. Scopus
3. Google Scholar
4. Indian Citation Index

1. How to check your publication in Web of Science?

(a) Open link: <http://ip-science.thomsonreuters.com/mjl/> and search (snap shot attached)

And check **journal name** in **Master Scopus list** available at <http://www.ncuindia.edu/ncu/research/rdil-guidelines-forms>

3. How to check your publication in Google scholar?

You may simply check for the title of paper in <https://scholar.google.co.in/> showing full length paper for authenticity.

Or

Confirm for the **last volume of the journal to be featured in Google Scholar** for considering it in the Google Scholar List.

4. How to check your publication in Indian Citation Index?

Check the **journal name** in **ICI report** available at <http://www.ncuindia.edu/ncu/research/rdil-guidelines-forms>

Or

Go to <http://www.indiancitationindex.com/> and register for free use for 30 days and check in search option (snapshot attached)
