#### Q1. When was the Institution established and by whom ?

The Institution was established in 1996 by Educate India Society.

- The Institution was first established as an "Engineering College" affiliated to Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak and approved by AICTE in the name and style of Institute of Technology & Management, more popularly known as ITM.
- In 2009, Institute of Technology & Management (ITM) was upgraded to the status of an "Autonomous Institute" by Govt. of Haryana.
- In 2010, Institute of Technology & Management (ITM) Autonomous Institute was further upgraded to a private selffinanced multi-disciplinary University in the name & style of ITM University.

#### Q2. Was the name of ITM University changed and when?

Yes. In 2015 the name was changed from ITM University to The NorthCap University.

## Q3. Under what authority is the University established?

It is established under Haryana Private University (Third Amendment) Act No. 25 of 2009 and subsequently under Ordinance No. 2 dated 22nd July 2015, issued by Government of Haryana.

#### Q4. Is the University approved and are the Degrees recognized by Government of India?

Yes. The NorthCap University is recognised by University Grants Commission (UGC), Ministry of HRD, Govt. of India under section 2(f). It has the right to confer degrees under section 22 of the UGC Act of 1956 and all its Degrees are recognized. The University is also recognized by Bar Council of India.

The University has also received UCG 12B status.

NCU is located at Sector 23-A, Gurugram, Haryana, India in the heartland of Gurugram. It is located 7 KM from Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. It is situated 2 KM from Industry Hub Udyog vihar,5 KM away from DLF Cyber City, Ambience mall, 6 km from 32nd Avenue and 18 KM from the Industry Hub of Manesar.

## Q7. Which is the closest Metro Station and is there last mile connectivity from the Metro Station to the University?

The nearest Metro Stations are Indusind Bank, Cyber City and IFFCO Chowk. Aside from the Metro Shuttle service, Auto- Rickshaws are available in abundance for last mile connectivity to and from the University. A metro station is also proposed in the next phase to be situated right next to the university.

# Q11. Are there any foreign language courses or certifications available at NCU?

Yes, The NorthCap University offers Foreign Language Electives (FLE) across all departments except the School of Law. Students can choose from a range of languages, including French, German, Spanish, and Mandarin. These electives are designed to enhance global competence and add value to students' academic and professional profiles.

# Q12. Can students switch specialisations (e.g., from core CSE to AI/ML) after admission or in the first year?

At The NorthCap University, students applying to all programmes can indicate their preferred specialisation (if any) in the application form at the time of admission.

For BTech programmes, the first year is common for all Computer Science specialisations. Students are required to finalise their specialisation—such as AI/ML, Data Science, Cyber Security, etc.—at the end of the second semester, based on academic performance and seat availability. A change of specialisation within the same branch is permitted at this stage.

- Master of Arts (MA) in Psychology


These programmes are designed to equip students with advanced knowledge and industry-relevant skills for future-ready careers.

## Q15. Is there any other fee?

There is no other fee/fund payable. However, at the time of admission the student is required to deposit an interest free refundable security deposit of Rs. 10,000, Alumni Association Fee of Rs. 1,000 and Industry Employability Aptitude Test fee (applicable for BTech & School of Management programs only) of Rs. 1,500 is payable. Youth Red Cross Fund Rs. 80 is payable by all students. The Annual Fee applicable at the time of admission is subject to a year-on-year increase of 3%.

#### Q17. How secure is the campus in terms of student safety, especially for girl students?

NCU offers a safe and secure campus environment, with special emphasis on the well-being of girl students. Security is tech-enabled with 24x7 CCTV surveillance, biometric attendance, and the Vizitor app to manage entry and exit. The campus is guarded round-the-clock and maintains a zero-tolerance anti-ragging policy to ensure emotional and physical safety. Regular audits, awareness programs, and a responsive support system further reinforce trust. At NCU, students can focus on their goals in a space built on security, respect, and inclusivity.

## Q18. Are scholarships available at the NorthCap University?.

NCU offers merit-cum-means and merit-based scholarships. The merit list is created after admissions are closed, and scholarships are awarded based on the defined criteria.

- Merit-Based Scholarships for Undergraduate Admissions: Avail up to 35% tuition fee waiver for BTech, BCA, BBA, BCom, BA and BSc programmes based on 12<sup>th</sup> grade performance (CBSE/equivalent board).
- UG NLT-Based Scholarships: Based on exceptional performance in national-level tests like JEE, CUET-UG, CLAT, and more.
- PG NLT-Based Scholarships: Available for postgraduate programmes based on national-level test scores such as GATE, CUET-PG, NIMCET, GMAT, CAT, XAT, SNAP, etc.
- PG Qualifying-Degree-Based Scholarships: Available for postgraduate programmes based on the qualifying undergraduate degree score. Eligibility: Minimum 60% marks or CGPA 6.0 and above in graduation.
- Single Girl Child Scholarship: 15% tuition fee scholarship for single girl students in undergraduate programmes.
- 10% Scholarship benefit on tuition fees for NCU Alumni.
- 25% Concession on tuition fees for university employees' ward(s) and spouse.
- 15% Concession on tuition fees for university alumni's ward(s) and spouse.
- 25% Fee Concession on the tuition fee to university (confirmed/regular) staff /employees admitted to the PhD Programme.

## Merit Scholarship Opportunities for Continuing Students

- Dean's List Merit Scholarship: 20% tuition fee waiver for students securing a CGPA of 9.50+ or achieving the top position in their batch (minimum CGPA 9.00), having cleared all subjects in the first attempt.
- AWS Certification Scholarship: Financial assistance is provided to the first 200 CSE students who successfully complete the AWS Cloud Practitioner Certification.
- Vice Chancellor's Merit Scholarship Scheme for Innovation (VCMSSI): Financial grants up to Rs. 15 lakhs per department (faculty-led) and Rs. 2 lakhs per student project to support innovation and research.

# Q19. Are there any other institutional scholarships available?

In collaboration with Hatch Associates India Pvt. Ltd., NCU offers financial support to meritorious girl students in STEM from, belonging to economically weaker sections. Eligible students must have a minimum 60% score in the previous semester and a family income below Rs. 10,00,000 per annum. The assistance is exclusive to students not receiving any other scholarship or aid.

# Q21. Do you have Hostels?

Yes. We have separate hostel facilities on twin-sharing basis for girls. The hostels are clean and hygienic with highspeed internet service and round the clock CCTV surveillance. They also have mess & recreational facilities within the hostel.

## Q22. What is the Hostel Fee?

The cost of boarding & lodging shall be Rs. 80,000/- per semester per student on double sharing basis. A refundable interest-free security deposit of Rs. 10,000/- will be applicable and will be released at the time of vacating the hostel after adjustment of fees, if any. Window Air-conditioner can be installed in every room by the inmates at their own cost. If an Air-conditioner is installed, the actual electricity bill based on meter reading will be extra and payable by the inmates.

## Q23. Is there PG Accommodation available, if I don't wish to stay in the hostel?

Yes. There are plenty of PG Accommodations available in the vicinity of the University.

## Q 24. Do you have transport facilities?

The University is very well connected from the Metro Stations for those who do not commute in their own vehicles. Shared cabs are also used extensively by students to & from the University to their respective residences. Availability of shared Taxi service is easily possible. The contact numbers of the Taxi Service can be shared by the University at the time of joining. These are private Taxi/ cab service providers and not under direct control of NCU.

# Q28. Are there any international exchange programmes or study abroad opportunities during the course?

# At NorthCap University we follow simple steps for admission:

# For Undergraduate Programmes: Step-by-step process:

- Register and Apply: Visit this website (https://apply.ncuindia.edu/)and fill out the application form.
- Submit Marks: After CBSE results are announced, submit your class 12th mark sheet.

- Merit List and Offer Letter Issue: Wait for the merit list to be created. You'll receive the offer letter at your Registered email address. Refer to the offer letter for details about the required documents, fees, payment deadline, and bank details.
- Campus Visit for Verification: Visit the campus for document verification and fee payment.

All original documents (except the Migration Certificate) will be returned after verification.

- Payment: Pay the fees as mentioned in the offer letter.
- **Registration and Credentials:** Once the fee is paid, you will be registered as a student, and your login credentials will be shared with you.
